RECAP

This week Pastor Tim challenged us to take an active role in bringing Jesus' compassion to the world around us. He challenged us, God's people, to be the ones who feed those in need. Tim challenged us to be more than receivers of grace. We are to be duplicators of the type of love and compassion Jesus has for the world.

▶ **Icebreaker Question:** If you had a whole morning to yourself, what would you do with your time and what breakfast would you eat?

DISCUSS

1. What does it look like to be compassionate to others? How does our context or culture control the way we are compassionate to others?
2. Read verses 37-38. What do you think of the disciples' response? Have you ever responded this way when you were called to be compassionate?
3. How have YOU served others in the past? In what ways are you currently serving or are interested in serving? If you are not serving, why?
4. How does showing compassion or serving others change the way we experience God's grace? Why do you think Jesus was so insistent that his disciples preach, drive out demons, heal and feed people?

As you close this week, discuss serving with your group. Make sure you have found ways to serve!
