RECAP

We continued into the first chapter of 1 John this week focusing on one, profound verse. Pastor Josh focused on the truth about who God is and the hopeful reminder of what that means for our lives.

ICEBREAKER QUESTION: What is one of your favorite fall traditions that you have with your family?

DISCUSS

KEY PASSAGE: 1 John 1:5

- 1. 1 John 1:5 begins with this statement "This is the message we heard from Jesus..." How would you finish that sentence? How would you summarize the message of Jesus in one sentence?
- 2. John answers the question above by saying in verse 5: God is light and there is no darkness in him at all. Why do you think he summarized Jesus' message in this way? What is the significance of a direct comparison to light and darkness in talking about God?
- 3. Despite us experiencing and witnessing darkness in this world and in our lives, what does it personally mean to you that God is light? What impact does that have on your life?
- 4. How can you grow in trusting God in this season? How can we help one another to grow in this area?
- 5. Like we did in services this past weekend, spend some time praying for one another. Share the darkness you feel burdened by and ask God to bring his light into those places. Pray to experience the comfort and peace found when we choose to trust God, even when we are in the middle of the darkness. Use Psalm 23 as a prayer guide if your group desires.
