RECAP

- 2. How do we mature in Christ? What does maturity look like and how does it benefit the church and community?
- 3. How do you abide, or spend time, in Christ? How long do you typically pray, read scripture, or dwell in the presence of God?
- 4. What does separation from God look like and feel like? How about separation from others in the church and our community? How do you reunite?
