RECAP

We continued in our *Summer in the Psalms* series this past weekend with a message on Psalm 8. Before jumping into the discussion with your group, pray together and invite the Holy Spirit to be present with you as you study and journey through this passage.

ICEBREAKER: Share about a time when you really felt seen, noticed, and appreciated by someone important in your life? What about that experience was meaningful to you?

DISCUSS

- 1. If you listened to Josh's message, share something that resonated with you, and why?
- 2. How does the message of Psalm 8 resonate with you? Can you relate to how David felt?
- 3. What can we learn about who God is, and who we are from this passage?
- 4. Have a few different people read Psalm 139:17-18; Psalm 8:3-6; & Hebrews 2:6-9. What is one truth that all 3 of these passages speak to us?
- 5. We learned this week that God is fully aware and always mindful of us at all times, and we are invited to be more mindful of God. It was said in the message this week:

"In as many ways as you can, as often as you can, for as long as you can allow your heart and your mind to be focused upon, filled by, and overwhelmed by God."

What practices (worship, scripture, prayer, community, etc.) might best help you grow in your mindfulness & awareness of God and his presence with you? How might you "practice the presence of God" in deeper ways this week?

Close in prayer together and praying for each other.

SCRIPTURE

KEY PASSAGE: Psalm 8 Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!

You have set your glory in the heavens.² Through the praise of children and infants you have established a stronghold against your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger. ³ When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, ⁴ what is mankind that you are mindful of them, human beings that you care for them? ⁵ You have made them a little lower than the angels and crowned them with glory and honor. ⁶ You made them rulers over the works of your hands; you put everything under their feet: 7 all flocks and herds, and the animals of the wild,⁸ the birds in the sky, and the fish in the sea, all that swim the paths of the seas. ⁹Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!

MEMORY VERSE: Psalm 8:9 "Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!"
