## SUNDAY RECAP

This past Sunday was week 10 of our series, **Out of Egypt, a study of the first 15 chapters of Exodus**. Before starting the discussion questions with your group, pray together and invite the Holy Spirit to be present with you.

**KEY PASSAGE:** Exodus 11:1-13:16

## DISCUSS

1. Pastor Donny reminded us that the laws and festivals given by God to Israel are gifts, not a punishment. How do you view God's laws and instructions to commemorate and remember these events? Why are these good gifts?
2. In Exodus 12:25 God commands Israel to "Observe this ceremony" of Passover. What is it for us on this side of the cross and resurrection of Jesus?
3. In the passage, God makes it clear that he doesn't like yeast. What does yeast represent? Reference 1 Corinthians 5:6-8.
4. Peter Enns in his commentary on Exodus says this: "Israel must not forget the terrible means by which their redemption was enacted. The sacrifice of the Passover Lamb is a constant reminder to Israel that their life came from death." How does this narrative point us to Jesus? What kind of impact does that have on you personally during this Lent season?
