Week 3 | 1 John 1:6-2:2





RECAP

This week we continued our series looking at the letters of John. Throughout this series we are going to see how Jesus transformed a disciple that was filled with anger and wrath into the disciple of love. Our goal is to reflect on how John's character changed so that we can be encouraged to be more like Jesus!

ICEBREAKER QUESTION: In the past, how have you discerned the voice of God?

DISCUSS

KEY PASSAGE: 1 John 1:6 - 1 John 2:2

MEMORY VERSE: 1 John 1:8-9

- 1. What does it mean to walk in the light?
- 2. Read verses 1 John 1:8-10 and 1 John 2:1-2. These verses focus on the greatest divider that we have from God, our own sin. John speaks specifically about not denying the fact that we do sin. As you have matured in your faith, have you ever had times that you had difficulty recognizing your own sin? What keeps us from confessing our sins before the Lord even though we know that he will forgive us?
- 3. John continues this thought in chapter 2 vs 9-11. He reminds us twice about the same point. How are we to respond to these verses as followers of Christ?
- 4. Reread 1 John 1:7. There is a greater implication here that points us back to Jesus' prayer for unity among believers found in John 17: 20-23. Discuss what this means for us as a body of believers.
