RECAP

ICEBREAKER QUESTION: What Christmas gift have you either given or received that resulted in great joy?

DISCUSS

KEY PASSAGE: You will grieve, but your grief will turn to joy. A woman giving birth to a child has pain because her time has come; but when her baby is born she forgets the anguish because of her joy that a child is born into the world. So with you: Now is your time of grief, but I will see you again and you will rejoice, and no one will take away your joy....You will have joy in me and it will be complete. John 16:20-24

MEMORY VERSE: The Word became flesh and blood, and moved into the neighborhood. John 1:14 MSG

- 1. Explore some differences and similarities between "happiness" and "joy."
- 2. Joy is one of the seven core values of Fair Oaks Church. How can a church community better practice the value of joy together?
- 3. In the message, Josh referred to 2 Corinthians 6:8-10. Read that together. What do you like about this passage? What don't you understand? What is it asking us to know or do?
- 4. After a challenging past two years for all of us, what are some areas in your life you would like God to create joy?
