RECAP

This week we continued our series looking at the letters of John. DISCUSS

KEY PASSAGE: 1 John 2:28 - 3:10; 3:19-24

MEMORY VERSE: 1 John 3:1-3

1. What was the biggest source of tension in your house growing up? How did that tension get resolved? What tension is present in this passage?
2. What does it mean to you to be called a Child of God? Why do you think God chose to save us? (Read Deuteronomy 7:7-11 and Ephesians 1:4-8)
3. What are the best ways to stay in the presence of Jesus throughout the day? What benefit do we have when we choose to remain in him?
4. Typically believers go back and forth between feeling confident in their faith and condemned by their sin. Does this happen to you? What do you do when you are feeling one way or the other?
