Week 9 | Psalm 62





RECAP

We concluded our *Summer in the Psalms* series this past weekend with a message on Psalm 62 (ESV). Before starting the discussion questions with your group, pray together and invite the Holy Spirit to be present with you as you study and journey through this passage.

ICEBREAKER: Which trip or vacation would you want to go back and relive again without changing anything?

DISCUSS

- 1. Psalm 62 has been referred to as a "trust Psalm." What portion of this passage speaks to you today and why?
- Pastor Josh emphasized the truth revealed in this Psalm about God being the ONLY one who we can put our hope in. Go through this Psalm again and identify the parts of this passage that highlight this concept. Which is the most challenging? Which is most comforting?
- 3. What does this teach us about who we are and who God is?
- 4. After meditating on this Psalm, ask God to reveal to you what He wants you to believe and do this week in response.
- 5. Share with your group how this series has impacted you over the last several weeks.
- 6. As you move into a prayer time with your group, practice praying the Psalms together. Use a verse or phrase from Psalm 62 as a prayer.

SCRIPTURE

KEY PASSAGE: Psalm 62 (Read it in a variety of translations - ESV, NIV, or others)

MEMORY VERSE:

Psalm 62:1-2

For God alone my soul waits in silence; from him comes my salvation. He alone is my rock and my salvation, my fortress; I shall not be greatly shaken.
