SUNDAY RECAP

- 1. What is something from the passage or message that stands out to you and why?
- 2. What does pride mean to you and why is it so destructive?
- 3. How do you keep God as the rightful head of your life? What has helped you remain aligned with Jesus and his priorities?
- 4. Are there any places in your life where you haven't submitted to God? What will you do about that?
- 5. Ryan said that "sin destroys, but God restores." How have you experienced the God of restoration in your life?
