- John 16:16-33
- Pray for God's wisdom to rightly understand the passage
- Questions
- 1. What do we look to for joy? What is the problem with seeking joy from these things?
- 2. In Jesus's final statements to His followers what does He want to communicate with them?
- 3. Note each time "joy" or "rejoice" is mentioned in the passage. What is Jesus trying to communicate about joy?
- 4. How do their circumstances in the world impact their joy?
- 5. What is Jesus trying to communicate when He tells them "no one will take your joy from you"?
- 6. What does it mean to pray "in the name of Jesus"? How does that impact our prayers and what we pray for?
- 7. Jesus says that when we receive what we ask for in the name of the Jesus, we will receive full joy. What does that mean?

- 8. God's will for His followers is unending and full joy. This is so good and generous! How is this possible (v.33)?
- 9. How can we be a people of the type of joy described in this passage?

## **Closing**

- Prayer: Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.
- Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people.
- Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
