- Questions
- 1. Light Opener: After going through a stressful experience, what do you do to unwind?
- 2. What is the immediate context of this passage? Briefly summarize what has transpired in the book of Acts thus far.
- 3. How did the believers respond to the apostles' report? What can we learn from this example?
- 4. When we pray, why is it helpful to recall the way God has acted in the past? Why is it helpful to use scripture to do that?

- 5. a. In what ways did the Apostles focus on the character of God as they prayed? How can focusing on God's character increase your boldness in prayer?
 b. Think through these character traits of God: Sovereign, Loving, Wise, Powerful, etc. How can each of these specifically bring boldness to your prayers?
- 6. How can your faith in God be expressed through the prayers you pray?
- 7. When was the last time you were amazed by the power of prayer?

3: Closing

- Prayer: Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.
- Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people.
- Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
