



1. Opening

Purpose for Digs and Prayer (1 min)

Digs gather to study, pray, and apply the Word of God to our lives. Our hope is that we would increase in our love for God, love for one another, and tell others about Him (Matt 22:37-40; Matt 28:19-20).

Weekly Christian Formation (5 min)

Question 37* How does the Holy Spirit help us?

Answer: The Holy Spirit convicts us of our sin, comforts us, guides us, gives us spiritual gifts and the desire to obey God; and he enables us to pray and to understand God's Word.

Scripture Reference: Ephesians 6:17-18

Recap (5 min)

Recap the last time your Dig Group gathered. How did you apply God's Word over the last week(s)?

2. Bible Study March 29nd (30-45 minutes)

*Read the passage aloud together.

*Pray for God's wisdom to rightly understand the passage.

Scripture Reference: Matthew 21:1-11

1. In Matthew 21:10 we see the people were "stirred up" and asked "who is this?" Take time to pray that our hearts and our city would be stirred by the coming of Jesus Christ.

2. Hosanna in Hebrew means "Save now" or "save us, we pray." Jesus came and saved us from the bondage of sin. What specific sin has He saved or delivered you from? Is there a sin that you wrestle with now that you need Him to save you from?

3. How does remembering what Jesus has saved you from change the way you face difficulties? How does remembering what Jesus has saved you from change the way you view sharing your testimony with others?

4. Do you find it hard to invite co-workers, neighbors, friends, to church? If so, why?

5. Who in your life needs to hear about the saving grace of Jesus Christ? Take time to pray for these individuals.

3. Confession and Prayer (30-45 minutes)

*Prayer: Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.

*Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people. Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
