- Questions

- 1. Recap John 13-16. What has Jesus told and shown His followers thus far in the Farewell Discourse?
- 2. At the time of this passage, how are Christ's followers feeling? Why?
- **3**. What does Jesus promise His followers in v.2? What does it mean to be "put out of the synagogue"?
- 4. Why does Jesus tell them such discouraging news? (v.1, 4)
- 5. Why is it more advantageous for Christ to go away?
- 6. What role does the Holy Spirit have in one's salvation? What role does the Christ-follower have?

- 7. How does understanding the historic context of a "comforter" help you understand this passage?
- 8. Reading verses 12-15, what can we learn about the Holy Spirit's relationship with the Father and Son?
- **9**. What things does Jesus want His followers to know in this passage? What things does He want His followers to do in this passage?
- **10**. What is keeping you from walking boldly to be Christ's witness? How can you better rest in the Comforter as you go into battle?

Closing

- Prayer: Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.
- Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people.
- Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
