## **Questions**

- 1. Up until this point, Jesus has said "my hour has not come" (2:4; 7:6, 8, 30; 8:20). Now in v.23, Jesus says that, "The hour has come." What is the significance of this statement?
- 2. In what ways will Jesus be glorified? How does death lead to glory?
- 3. How does Christ "hate" his life? Whose will is He following in v.27-28?
- 4. We are called to imitate Christ. How are we to "hate" our lives?
- 5. Read v.42-43. In what ways do we have a belief like the authorities? Do you think their belief is a saving belief or like the belief described in John 8:44?
- 6. How will hating our lives and desiring God's glory above our own shape our prayers, our time, our finances, our schedules, our relationships?
- 7. In what ways are you seeking the wrong glory? What do you need to lay down in order to follow Jesus?

## **Closing**

- Prayer: Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.
- Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people.
- Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
