



1. Opening

Purpose for Digs and Prayer (1 min)

Weekly Christian Formation (5 min)

Question 39* With what attitude should we pray?

Scripture Reference: Revelation 21:1-22:5

1. Why was the Book of Revelation given to the seven churches?

2. What were the charges given to the seven churches? What promises were given to the seven churches?

3. What enemies have been defeated throughout Revelation?

4. In this passage, all enemies have already been defeated and God is making all things new. How would you summarize the core message of the promises of this passage?

5. Our future hope is that the dwelling place of God will be with man. All of the promises to the seven churches are fulfilled. How do the images of the Bride, New Jerusalem, and the restored Garden (River of Life, Tree of Life) help us to grasp what it will be like to dwell with God?

6. Knowing God's ultimate plan, how do the promises of this chapter shape the way you live today?

3. Confession and Prayer (30-45 minutes)

***Prayer:** Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.

***Prayer Challenge:** Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people. Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
