- 2. What can we learn about gospel ministry from the apostles here in Acts 5:17-42?
- 3. The apostles were faced with opposition because they were sharing the gospel. Should we expect opposition when we share the gospel?
- 4. What does this passage teach us about civil disobedience?

- 5. Why should the act of spreading the gospel bring joy?
- 6. What does this passage teach about God's sovereignty in the midst of suffering and persecution?
- 7. Pray for the persecuted church around the world.

## 3: Closing

- Prayer: Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.
- Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people.
- Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
