4. How is the Holy Spirit described in this passage? What is the Holy Spirit according to this passage?
5. In this passage, who does the Holy Spirit come from and who is it given to?
6. How do we continue to walk in step with the Spirit?
7. How does the assurance and gift of the Holy Spirit change the way a Christ follower lives?

- Prayer: Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.
- Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people.
- Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
