4. Discuss in what ways you have met each others needs.
5. Discuss how you could be better at meeting each others needs.
6. We learned that Barnabas was an encourager and loved others well. How can we go throughout encouraging and loving others in the same manner this week?

- Prayer: Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.
- Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people.
- Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
