### **Interpretation**

5. Who are the thieves and robbers of today?
6. What does it mean that Jesus is the Door?
7. In verse 18, why is it so important to know that Jesus laid down His life? It wasn't man nor the Father that killed Jesus?

### **Application**

8. In what areas of your life do you need to trust in the Good Shepherd?
9. In what areas of your life is the thief pulling you away from the fold? How can you trust in the Good Shepherd?

- Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people.
- Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
