- 1. In chapter 1, what mission and promise did Jesus give His disciples?
- 2. In chapter 1, what are the disciples doing? (1:4, 1:14)
- 3. How does God fulfill His promise and begin His mission in Acts 2?
- 4. In what ways do we see the providence of God in Acts 2?
- 5. How is the Holy Spirit described in Acts 2?
- 6. What did the tongues of fire proclaim?
- 7. How do the crowd respond to the tongues of fire?

- 8. Who is the hero of this passage, the disciple in their proclamation or God through His empowering Spirit?
- 9. What are some of the marks of the early church that we have seen in the first two chapters of Acts?
- 10. What can we learn from looking at the attributes of the early church about how we should be as the church today?
- 11. What should you do as a result of what you've learned from the early church?
