



1. Opening

Purpose for Digs and Prayer (1 min)

Digs gather to study, pray, and apply the Word of God to our lives. Our hope is that we would increase in our love for God, love for one another, and tell others about Him (Matt 22:37-40; Matt 28:19-20).

Weekly Christian Formation (5 min)

Question 35* What do we believe about the Holy Spirit?

Answer: That he is God, coeternal with the Father and the Son, and that God grants him irrevocably to all who believe.

Scripture Reference: John 14:16-17

2. Bible Study March 22nd (30-45 minutes)

*Read the passage aloud together.

*Pray for God's wisdom to rightly understand the passage.

Scripture Reference: Revelation 20:1-15

1. Read Revelation 20:1-3. In what ways do we see God's sovereign power displayed? How are these verses an encouragement to the church?

2. Read v.4-6. What are the 1st and 2nd resurrections? What are the 1st and 2nd deaths? What reassurance do these verses give to Christians who experience death before Jesus returns?

3. Read v.7-10. How does reading about this battle help Christians who might be feeling completely surrounded by the enemy in their personal circumstances even now before the final battle? Can the enemy, as numerous as the sand of the sea, harm the saints?

4. As you read about the Great White Throne in v.11-15, how do you see God's grace? How do these verses bring assurance to the church?

5. Revelation 20 has been written for the hope of the church, that the church might persevere. How does this passage bring hope to your circumstances?

3. Confession and Prayer (30-45 minutes)

*Prayer: Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.

*Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people. Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
