

1. Opening

Purpose for Digs and Prayer (1 min)

Digs gather to study, pray, and apply the Word of God to our lives. Our hope is that we would increase in our love for God, love for one another, and tell others about Him (Matt 22:37-40; Matt 28:19-20).

Weekly Christian Formation (5 min)

Question 20* Who is the Redeemer?

Answer: The only Redeemer is the Lord Jesus Christ, the eternal Son of God, in whom God became man and bore the penalty for sin himself.

Scripture Reference: 1 Timothy 2:5

2. Bible Study November 2 (30-45 minutes)

- *Read the passage aloud together.
- *Pray for God's wisdom to rightly understand the passage.

Scripture Reference: Revelation 6:1-17

- 1. Look back at Revelation 5. What is the scroll? Who is worthy to open it? Why is He worthy to open it?
- 2. In Revelation 6, 6 of the seals are opened on scroll. In the first four seals, what do we learn about God's plan?
- 3. Why is the message of the first four seals and important message for the church?

- 4. Matthew 24 is a complementary passage of Revelation 6, describing the time between the first and second comings of Christ. Read Matthew 24:9-14. How does this passage help increase our understanding of the contents of Revelation 6?
- 5. When the fifth seal is opened, we see the cry of martyred souls (v.9-11). What was given to them? What was told to them? Why are these things important for the church to know?
- 6. The sixth seal marks the time near the return of Christ (v.12-17). What happens when this seal is opened? Why is this important for the church to know?
- 7. How is God encouraging His church in this passage? How does this passage impact your life?

3. Confession and Prayer (30-45 minutes)

Prayer: Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.

Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people. Pray that you will make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6)
