- **Acts 1:12-26**
- Pray for God's wisdom to rightly understand the passage
- **Questions**
 1. Recap the context of Acts 1:1-11. What mission to Jesus give His disciples? What were they commanded to do until the Holy Spirit came upon them in power (v.4)?
 2. In Acts 1:12, we see that the disciples were being obedient to Jesus' command. Discuss the different types of people listed in v.13-15. What is the significance of having this group all in one room?
 3. What would it look like for them to be "with one accord"? What does "one accord" not look like?
 4. How else are the disciples described in v.14?
 5. What does it mean to be devoted to prayer?
 6. In light of the mission Jesus gave to the disciples in Acts 1:8, why is devotion to prayer a significant activity for the disciples?
 7. What does this passage teach us about the type of people God uses?

8. How can you grow, with one accord, in devotion to prayer?

- **Prayer:** Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.
- **Prayer Challenge:** Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people.
- Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
