- Questions

- 1. Recap the context of Acts 1:1-11. What mission to Jesus give His disciples? What were they commanded to do until the Holy Spirit came upon them in power (v.4)?
- 2. In Acts 1:12, we see that the disciples were being obedient to Jesus' command. Discuss the different types of people listed in v.13-15. What is the significance of having this group all in one room?
- 3. What would it look like for them to be "with one accord"? What does "one accord" not look like?
- 4. How else are the disciples described in v.14?
- 5. What does it mean to be devoted to prayer?
- 6. In light of the mission Jesus gave to the disciples in Acts 1:8, why is devotion to prayer a significant activity for the disciples?
- 7. What does this passage teach us about the type of people God uses?

8. How can you grow, with one accord, in devotion to prayer?

- Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people.
- Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
