



1. Opening

Purpose for Digs and Prayer (1 min)

Digs gather to study, pray, and apply the Word of God to our lives. Our hope is that we would increase in our love for God, love for one another, and tell others about Him (Matt 22:37-40; Matt 28:19-20).

Weekly Christian Formation (5 min)

Question 40* What should we pray?

Answer: The whole Word of God directs and inspires us in what we should pray, including the prayer Jesus himself taught us.

Scripture Reference: Ephesians 3:14-21

What does this mean? How does it impact our lives?

Recap (5 min)

Recap the last time your Dig Group gathered. How did you apply God's Word over the last week(s)?

2. Bible Study April 19th (30-45 minutes)

*Read the passage aloud together.

*Pray for God's wisdom to rightly understand the passage.

Scripture Reference: Revelation 22:6-21

1: How has studying the book of Revelation stretched your understanding or challenged your own opinions about this book?

2: In what practical ways can remembering that "Jesus is coming soon" strengthen your hope and trust in God when life feels hard or uncertain?

3: Revelation 22:8-9 describes John falling to his knees after being given this revelation. He begins to worship an angel and is called out for it. Do you find yourselves at times tempted to worship the good things God has given you instead of God Himself?

4: John is in awe of what he has seen and heard. When you read or hear God's Word how often are you truly moved to awe and worship? What practical steps can you take to give God proper worship?

5: Revelation 22:11 describes people continuing on their current path — either toward evil/filth or toward righteousness/holiness. As you reflect on your own life, which direction are you heading right now?

6: Read Revelation 22:17
Revelation 22:17 extends a free invitation: "And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who desires take the water of life without price." Who in your life needs to hear this invitation right now?

3. Confession and Prayer (30-45 minutes)

*Prayer: Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.

*Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people. Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
