



1. Opening

Purpose for Digs and Prayer (1 min)

Digs gather to study, pray, and apply the Word of God to our lives. Our hope is that we would increase in our love for God, love for one another, and tell others about Him (Matt 22:37-40; Matt 28:19-20).

Weekly Christian Formation (5 min)

Question 33* Should those who have faith in Christ seek their salvation through their own works, or anywhere else?

Answer: No, they should not, as everything necessary to salvation is found in Christ. To seek salvation through good works is a denial that Christ is the only Redeemer and Savior.

2. Bible Study February 15 (30-45 minutes)

*Read the passage aloud together.

*Pray for God's wisdom to rightly understand the passage.

Scripture Reference: Revelation 15:1-16:21

1. Describe a time when you saw or heard about injustice. How did it make you feel?
2. Discuss the type of injustice that the church is facing and will face in the tribulation? (Refer back to Rev 13)

3. Read Revelation 15:1 and 16:17. How does it make you feel that through the wrath of God all injustice will be finished?

4. In Revelation 15:3-4 and Revelation 16:5-6, God's attributes are declared. What attributes are given to God?

5. How does holding onto these attributes help you to have a right understanding of God you read about the bowls of God's wrath?

6. In Revelation 15:2 it mentions "those who had conquered". Who are those who have conquered? How have they conquered? Do Christians actually defeat the beast or does God? What does it mean to conquer here?

7. How does this passage, revealing the completion of God just wrath upon evil and revealing the song of redemption, help you to remain steadfast in the faith?

8. How can you better fix your eyes on this hope we have in Jesus?

3. Confession and Prayer (30-45 minutes)

*Prayer: Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.

*Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people. Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
