## **Formation**

**Question 8\*** What is the law of God stated in the Ten Commandments?

Answer: You shall have no other gods before me. You shall not make for yourself an idol in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below—you shall not bow down to them or worship them. You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God. Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. Honor your father and your mother. You shall not murder. You shall not commit adultery. You shall not steal. You shall not give false testimony. You shall not covet.

## 2. August 10 Sermon - Study Questions | Revelation 1:1-8

- \*Read the passage aloud together.
- \*Pray for God's wisdom to rightly understand the passage.
- 1. What is the purpose for the Book of Revelation? (see Rev 1:1; 22:6) What does this tell us about the comprehensibility of the content of this book?
- 2. Knowing the type of literature is really important in understanding Revelation. What types of literature does Revelation fall into? (Rev 1:1, 3, 4)

- 3. What kinds of things will "soon take place" after the ascension of Jesus? In light of that, what then does John direct our attention to in this passage? (the nature of our salvation, the attributes of God)
- 4. What does this passage tell us about our salvation in Christ?
- 5. What does this passage tell us about the attributes of God?
- 6. If the church will soon face trials, why is it important to focus these two things (nature of our salvation and attributes of God)? How will knowing these two things help the Church through trials?
- 7. If being anchored to these truths is an important part of our perseverance, what do you need to do to anchor yourself to these truths so that you have them when you face trials?

## 3. Closing Time of Prayer

Prayer: Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.

Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people. Pray that you will make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
