Questions | Joshua 1:1-9

***Read the passage aloud together.**

***Pray for God's wisdom to rightly understand the passage.**

1. Recap from the last time your Dig Group gathered. How did you apply God's Word over the last week(s)?
2. Read John 15:1-5. What does it mean for us to abide? What can we do with and without abiding?
3. Read Deuteronomy 6:1-9. How does this passage set the framework for obedience to Joshua 1?
4. In Joshua 1, God's people are about to enter the Promised Land. How does the context of Exodus-Joshua point us to our salvation in Jesus?
5. What is the mission in Joshua 1:2-3?

6. How is this mission similar to our mission as Christians found in Matthew 28:18-20?
7. What promise is given in both Joshua 1:5 and Matthew 28:20 as a premise for ability to faithfully follow the command?
8. How is that promise helpful as we seek to follow God's Word without turning to the right or left?
9. What is the command in Joshua 1:8? How often are they to obey that command? How does Deuteronomy 6 help explain what Scripture meditation should look like?
10. How can you grow in abiding in God's Word?

3. Closing Time of Prayer

Prayer: Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.

Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people. Pray that you will make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
