- Questions

- 1. In what ways was Pilate, not Jesus, actually the one "on trial"?
- 2. Read John 5:44. What prevents belief in God?
- 3. Read Leviticus 24:16. What was, at least ostensibly, the reason the Jews sought Jesus' death?
- 4. Read Judges 8:23 and 1 Samuel 8:4-7. In God's ideal plan, who is to be the king of Israel?
- 5. In what ways is the climactic cry "We have no king by Caesar" ironic?
- 6. In what ways do you cry "I have no king by Caesar" in your life right now?

- 7. Read Hebrews 12:2. What was the "joy" set before Jesus?
- 8. How should we feel when we reflect on Jesus' suffering?

Closing

- Prayer: Reserve plenty of time to pray for one another.
- Prayer Challenge: Pray that God would provide opportunities for you to share Christ with people.
- Pray that you would make the most of every opportunity (Col 4:2-6).
