It's About Time to: **Become AWARE of God's Plan**

In Mark 5, Jesus reveals a plan to a desperate man.

Then a leader of the local synagogue, whose name was Jairus, arrived. When he saw Jesus, he fell at his feet, ²³ pleading fervently with Him. "My little daughter is dying," he said. "Please come and lay your hands on her; heal her so she can live."

Mark 5:22-23

To be aware of God's plan, we must talk to Him.

Jesus went with him, and all the people followed, crowding around him. Mark 5:24

God's plan is healing the daughter. On the way, a woman grabs Him.

Woman with issue of bleeding. Hem of the garment. But I'm waiting. Delay doesn't mean denial. 12 years, go, your faith has healed you.

While he was still speaking to her, messengers arrived from the home of Jairus, the leader of the synagogue. They told him, "Your daughter is dead. There's no use troubling the Teacher now." Mark 5:35

When it seems like hope is lost, Connect to His Plan.

But Jesus overheard them and said to Jairus, "Don't be afraid. Just have faith." Mark 5:36

Jesus says Trust the Plan. When they got home, there were mourners.

Jesus puts them out and tells the little girl to get up!

And the girl, who was twelve years old, immediately stood up and walked around! They were overwhelmed and totally amazed.

Mark 5:42

His plan hadn't changed even when it looked like all was lost.

When <u>STORMS COME</u>, It's About Time to: Reconnect to God's Plan

Then Jesus got into the boat and started across the lake with His disciples. ²⁴ **Suddenly**, a fierce storm struck the lake, with waves breaking into the boat. But Jesus was sleeping. Matthew 8:23-24 Have you ever felt like Jesus was asleep when you needed Him?

The disciples went and woke Him up, shouting, "Lord, save us! We're going to drown!" Matthew 8:25

The Plan hadn't changed. He was there with them! Why are you afraid?

Jesus responded, "Why are you afraid? You have so little faith!" Then He got up and rebuked the wind and waves, and suddenly there was a great calm. Matthew 8:26

We love to preach on how He calmed the storm, but he rebuked them 1st.

Immediately after this, Jesus insisted that His disciples get back into the boat and head across the lake to Bethsaida, while He sent the people home. ⁴⁶ After telling everyone good-bye, He went up into the hills by Himself to pray. Mark 6:45-46

Look here's my plan...Later that night they were In the boat

He saw that they were in **serious trouble**, rowing hard and **struggling** against the wind and waves. Mark 6:48a

He sees you in serious trouble, struggling, when you can't see Him. Reconnect to His plan.

About three o'clock in the morning Jesus came toward them, walking on the water. He intended to go past them, Mark 6:48 I heard someone say, the plan hadn't changed! I told you I'd meet you.

But when they saw Him walking on the water, they cried out in terror, thinking He was a ghost. Mark 6:49

We're so ready to believe in ghosts, but not His plan!

Jesus said, Don't be afraid, I'm here. He calmed the storm.

On the other side of the storm was still His plan!

What has God asked you to do but you're too focused on your storm?

But the Lord's plans stand firm forever; His intentions can never be shaken. Psalm 33:11

He hasn't changed His mind about you! Will you trust His Plan?
