



Sermon Title: Our God is the God of Crazy

Scripture: [Acts 12:1-16](#), [Luke 24:8-12](#)

Questions:

1. Do you think that God still does miracles? Do you pray with expectancy for God to do miracles in your life?
2. How does thinking about a veil covering your eyes (or someone else's eyes) change the way you need to be praying about situations in your life?
3. In what ways do you think you are going through religious motions and need to develop a deeper awareness of the Spirit of God and the crazy things God may want you to be doing?
4. In what ways are you too comfortable in life? In what ways does your life look too similar to the rest of the world? What is one "crazy" thing that God may be asking you to change in order live set apart?
5. When you think about the moment of Jesus' resurrection, who do you think you would be? The ones who called it crazy, or the one who ran toward the tomb? Who do you want to be? What do you need to change in your life in order to be postured to respond that way?

Prayer:

- **Make a commitment to participate in 21 Days of Prayer Jan. 10-29 from 6:45p-7:45p in the sanctuary. If you are using this discussion guide as a group, share your commitment with one another so you can keep each other accountable.**
- Pray for God to bind the spirits that blind and release the spirit of wisdom and revelation over your life - that He may remove any veils that are keeping you from seeing Him in fullness and seeing clearly what it is He may be calling you to.

- Spend some time reflecting on some of the crazy things that God did in the Bible. Ask the Spirit to use these ebenezers as a way to help change your view of God.
- Ask God to change your heart and help you to be open to and expectant for the crazy, unexpected, radical, impossible ways that God wants to move.
- What is one thing your life that you need God to do the impossible? Spend some time asking for God to do what you may not even think is possible - in Jesus' name!
