- 3. <u>Read Matthew 4:18-22</u> and <u>Matthew 9:9</u>. Why did Peter, Andrew, James, John and Matthew drop everything and follow Jesus?
- 4. Read Matthew 11:28-30. How does understanding Jewish discipleship give us a deeper meaning of this passage? What is Jesus' yoke compared to the Pharisees' yoke?
- 5. <u>Read Matthew 14:25-31</u> and <u>Matthew16:21-25</u>. How does understanding Jewish discipleship give us a deeper meaning of these passages?
- 6. Do you believe that you can be like and do like Jesus in every way and every day? Why or Why not? How can we live this way? In what ways can we live this way as K1?
