**WEEK FIVE** The Resolute Redeemer Joshua 1:1-9



#### MARKET PLACE REDEMPTION

In the marketplace, the term "redeem" is often associated with a coupon or voucher indicating that a retailer is giving the consumer an opportunity to receive a discount on a particular item or service. The coupon must be **presented** at the time of purchase in order to receive the benefit. If this takes place, the benefit is REDEEMED.

#### KINGDOM REDEMPTION

In the church the term redemption is related to God the Father sending His Son Jesus to **deliver**, release and restore sinners from their sin and its consequences by means of His sacrifice (Jn. 8:36). Similar to the marketplace, the act of BELIEF by **FAITH** must be taken in order to receive the benefit of forgiveness and eternal life (Jn. 3:16, Rm. 10:9-10). When someone puts their faith in Christ as Savior and Lord, they are REDEEMED (1 Peter 1:18-19).

The process of redeeming God's promises *should* continue in the life of the believer throughout their walk with the Lord. When God speaks, the recipient has been given an opportunity to redeem the **promises** associated with that Word. But if the transaction of faith (corresponding act of obedience) isn't taken, the promise may go unredeemed (James 2:14-26).

### RESOLUTE REDEEMING

This process is clearly seen in the life of Joshua as God prepares him to take over where Moses left off. Joshua 1:1-9 records God explaining to Joshua that the promise was connected to his **obedience**. Verses 6-7 give details of the promise of God and action required by Joshua for its REDEMPTION. We also can and must "be strong and very courageous... be careful TO DO" what God has commanded. Because you have been redeemed, you have access to many more REDEEMABLE PROMISES from God. Don't allow any desires of the Lord for your life to expire due to a lack of redeeming obedience. Be a resolute (firm determination)DOER and reap the miraculous rewards!
