**SCRIPTURE:** 2 Timothy 3:10-14 (ESV)

<sup>10</sup> You, however, know all about my teaching, my way of life, my purpose, faith, patience, love, endurance, <sup>11</sup> persecutions, sufferings—what kinds of things happened to me in Antioch, Iconium and Lystra, the persecutions I endured. Yet the Lord rescued me from all of them. <sup>12</sup> In fact, everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted, <sup>13</sup> while evildoers and impostors will go from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived. <sup>14</sup> But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it.

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

### 1. Preach the Word (Reflect Christ Publicly)

Paul reminds Timothy that he has followed his teaching and way of life. As followers of Christ, we're called not just to live privately but to proclaim the good news.

- What does it look like to “preach” in everyday life without using a pulpit?
- Who in your life might need to hear the gospel through your words and actions this week?

### 2. Present the Truth (Hold Fast to Sound Doctrine)

Paul encourages Timothy to remain in the truth he has learned and believed, especially in times of deception.

- How can you stay rooted in God's truth when the world promotes so many alternatives?
- What helps you discern biblical truth from spiritual confusion?

### **3. Promote Awareness (Live Alert in Faith)**

Timothy witnessed Paul's trials and perseverance. Followers of Jesus must remain spiritually alert and discerning.

- In what areas of your life is God calling you to be more spiritually watchful?
- How does spiritual awareness help you respond to life's challenges differently?
