WEEK SEVEN: Exponential Grace Spreaders

INTRODUCTION

Last week Pastor Joseph redefined "Grace" as God influencing souls, turning them to Christ and kindling them to exercise the Christian virtues. In short, we learned that grace is God's supernatural power operating in and through the believer. This week we will explore the purpose of Xponential Grace operating in and through us, and how we are to spread it.

XPONENTIAL GRACE SPREADERS

For all things are for your sakes, so that the grace which is spreading [being multiplied] to more and more people may cause the giving of thanks to abound [overflow] to the glory of God. 2 Corinthians 4:15

The supernatural power (grace) given to the church by the Holy Spirit is not only for us to endure our Christian walk. Grace has a much higher purpose. By God's Grace the exponents of Jesus should bring glory to God by causing the people around them to give thanks. Just as wisdom bears children, grace does also. Xponential Grace produces thanksgiving and gives glory to God through Xponential Works.

TO SPREAD OR NOT TO SPREAD (ACTS 3:1-10)

As Xponents of Christ we cannot close our eyes to the daily opportunities God gives us to spread grace. Peter and John were going about their day not looking to perform a miracle, but once the lame man asked for help they gave him more than what he expected. Xponential Grace recognizes a need and gives more than what is expected.

Xponential Grace steps up to the plate. Once the apostles recognized the man's need, they committed themselves to do something for him. By God's Grace the Xponents of Jesus can be the answer to a world in need. We cannot be people of grace and close our eyes to the needs around us.

The apostles knew they didn't have what the man was asking for, but gave him what they did have. As Xponents of Christ, God doesn't expect us to give what we don't have or do what we cannot do. He expects us to give out of the grace He has given us.

WHAT I HAVE, I GIVE YOU...

Not all of us have the same grace to give, but as Xponents of Jesus, all of us have some grace to give to someone.

And as you go, preach, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.' Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, cast out demons. Freely you received, freely give. Matthew 10:7-8 (NASB)
