²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

1. Love (Agape)

- **Definition**: Unconditional, sacrificial love that seeks the highest good of others.
- Discussion Questions:
 - o How can we show agape love in our daily interactions?

2. Joy (Chara)

- **Definition**: A deep, abiding, inner rejoicing that is not dependent on circumstances.
- Discussion Questions:
 - o What are some ways we can cultivate joy in our lives?

3. Peace (Eirene)

- **Definition**: Inner tranquility and calmness of mind, resting in God's sovereignty.
- Discussion Questions:
 - o In what situations do you find it challenging to maintain peace?

4. Forbearance (Patience) (Makrothumia)

• **Definition**: Long-suffering, endurance, and the ability to tolerate delays or suffering without becoming angry or upset.

• Discussion Questions:

o How do we practice patience with others, especially in frustrating situations?

5. Kindness (Chrestotes)

- **Definition**: Benevolence and a tender concern for others, often expressed through gentle and generous actions.
- Discussion Questions:
 - o Share an example of a time when someone showed you kindness.

6. Goodness (Agathosune)

- **Definition**: Moral integrity and the desire to do good to others; righteousness in action.
- Discussion Questions:
 - o How can we promote goodness in our communities?

7. Faithfulness (Pistis)

- **Definition**: Loyalty, reliability, and trustworthiness in our relationship with God and others.
- Discussion Questions:
 - o In what ways can we strengthen our faithfulness to God?

8. Gentleness (Prautes)

- **Definition**: Meekness and humility, strength under control.
- Discussion Questions:
 - o Why is gentleness important in our interactions with others?

9. Self-Control (Egkrateia)

- **Definition**: The ability to control one's desires and impulses, exercising discipline and restraint.
- Discussion Questions:
 - o What areas of your life require more self-control?
