Psalm 132:13-18 CSB

Zion (The people of God)

God's Promise to the House (Psalm 132:13-18)

- 1. He has chosen His Church
- 2. He is resting with (settling upon) His people
- 3. He will abundantly bless His people
- 4. He will satisfy the needs of His people
- 5. The leaders and servants will facilitate their divine calling
- 6. He will guide His anointed through the Word (Psalm 119:105)
- Our enemies (haters) will be ashamed and some will become allies (e.g. neighbors)

Example: The Queen of Sheba - 1 Kings 10:1-9

Observations of a One Accord Church

- 1. Jesus Christ is central (not a denomination)
- 2. A Spirit-filled, Spirit-led, Scripture soaked atmosphere
- 3. A House of Prayer for all people (Isaiah 56:7 NIV)
- 4. A place of corroborate care and community impact
- 5. A place of honor and respect for leadership, elders, women, men, and youth
- 6. A place of elevated and corporate and unified praise and worship

Factor Points

- 1. **Worship** God is here, therefore we worship the One God with one accord.
- 2. **Learn** The Holy Spirit has come to lead, guide, instruct, and evolve us into the image of Jesus Christ before others.
- 3. **Serve** We move **TOGETHER** to facilitate Kingdom transformation within the earth.
