AAAPRAYERS

What does the practice of abiding look like in practical day-to-day life?

According to previous teachings, WORSHIP, LEARN and SERVE are all forms of abiding. Prayer, however, is a common thread that runs through every discipleship activity.

"If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you."-Jesus, (John 15:7).

Not only are we abiding when we pray, we also receive greater answers to our prayers when we abide. Why? Because of the AAA Prayer Pattern Jesus revealed in John 15:7.

"[A]bide in Me" — Worship/Serve "My words [A]bide in you" — <u>Learn</u>

"[A]sk... it will be done for you." Receive

This pattern reveals a key to answered prayer because when we abide through worshiping, serving and learning, we discover God's will and connect with God's heart.

facilitates This connection the transformation of our own hearts and desires, which then leads us to pray, NOT simply for what we desire, but in agreement with what God desires for ourselves and others (Ps. 37:4).

If we abide first, we'll always ask according to His will.

It's through abiding that our prayer lives become truly fulfilling and fruitful.

Monday: ·

Lord I thank You for the opportunity not only to receive Jesus as my Lord and Savior, but also to walk with Him in the intimacy of abiding. Thank You Jesus for allowing me to be **connected to You**. Thank You Holy Spirit for reminding me of what I've been taught and **changing me day-by-day** into the image of Christ from the inside out as I abide (John 14:26). Teach me to dwell in Your presence everywhere I go today. Give me the grace to bear fruit that brings **You glory** (2 Corinthians 12:9). In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Tuesday:

Today O Lord, I worship You because You are good and You are worthy to be praised (Psalm 145:3). Thank You for the privilege of abiding in Your presence through worship. As I worship, I pray that You **reveal Yourself to me** in a more intimate and personal way (Psalm 27:8, 11). Teach me to receive Your peace that surpasses all understanding (Philippians 4:7). Thursday: -

Today O Lord, as I abide in Your Word, give me the grace to meditate on Your truth in the midst of all the lies and deceit in this world (Psalm 119:48). Your Word is life and is a lamp to my feet (Psalm 119:105). As the Word reveals Your character, Your will and Your ways, I will seek to follow and obey as I abide in You (Psalm 119:11). I stand on Your promises and trust in Your timing. In Jesus' name. Amen..

Friday:

Father Your Word says that if I delight myself in You, You will give me the desires of my heart (Psalm 37:4). Lord as I abide in You, I delight in You and I pray that my joy is made full and overflows in Your presence (John 15:11). From this place of joy and intimacy with You, I pray according to Your will. May all that I want, be in agreement with Your perfect will. And to You O Lord be the glory, the honor and the praise. In Jesus' name. Amen.

Saturday: -

Lord Jesus I thank You for being the True Vine that I and every believer are called to abide in, be transformed and bear much fruit (John 15:1). Thank You for the exponential increase of abiding prayer in the Body of Christ. Make us one as You and the Father are One (John 17:21).
