"Now to him who is able to strengthen you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery that was kept secret for long ages but has now been disclosed and through the prophetic writings has been made known to all nations, according to the command of the eternal God, to bring about the obedience of faith—to the only wise God be glory forevermore through Jesus Christ! Amen."

# **DISCUSSION**

- 1. The Source of Stability
  - Paul declares that it is God who strengthens us.
  - What does it mean for God—not ourselves—to be the one who establishes us?
  - o In what areas of your life are you seeking stability right now?
- 2. The Gospel and Revelation
  - Paul speaks of "my gospel" and the "revelation of the mystery."
  - o How does the gospel bring both salvation and ongoing stability to our faith?
  - Why is prayer an important part of receiving revelation from God?
- 3. Prayer That Leads to Obedience
  - Paul says the mystery was revealed to bring about "the obedience of faith."
  - o How does prayer help us not only hear God's word but also obey it?
  - Can you think of a time when prayer revealed something that required your obedience?
- 4. Glory to God Alone
  - Paul ends with a doxology: "to the only wise God be glory forevermore."
  - How does prayer keep us centered on God's glory rather than our own desires?
  - What would it look like for your prayer life this week to be more about God's glory?
