**WEEK ONE Used To Be or Still Am?** Ezekiel 33:30-33, Romans 10:1, James 2:17



## **BEGIN BEFORE THE END**

We began the year with a series called **REVISION**. It was about adjusting our vision and embracing the foresight of a God-inspired future. Now led by the Holy Spirit, we will end the year with **RESOLUTION**. Many people determine to do something new and make desired changes in their lives at the beginning of a new year; thus, we get the phrase "New Year's Resolution".

**RESOLUTION**: the act of determining **RESOLUTE**: marked by firm <u>determination</u>

We are deciding to make a firm determination before the current year ends and the new year begins. Why? Because if what we have received this year is of true <u>value</u> for our growth, discipleship and fulfillment of God's will for our lives, then we must <u>honor</u> the Lord and the Word by doing what He said.

## **USED TO BE OR STILL AM?**

Before we look ahead to the NEXT NEW THING, let's determine with resolute hearts to look back, take a firm hold of the truths we have been given and put the Word to work. There is a habit in the Body of Christ to be hearers only and celebrate what we have heard (Ez. 33:30-33). The Word of the Lord is meant to do more than feel good to our natural senses. The Word guides us into His perfect will (Ps. 119:105).

The reality is that the church is full of "Used To-Be's". Used To-Be Addicts, Used To-Be Liars, Used To-Be Angry, Used To-Be Lustful, Used To-Be Materialistic, Used To-Be Arrogant, etc... The difference between a "Used To-Be" and a "Still Is" is the choice to both HEAR and DO the Word of God.

One of the reasons we don't DO is that we often only demonstrate our faith in **hearing** what God says **and** believing for IT (the hearing of the Word) to change us. Instead, we should hear what God said and demonstrate our faith by doing it and then **experience the God-intended transformation**. Hearing is only half the experience.

"So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ." -Romans 10:17

"Even so faith, if it has no works, is dead, being by itself." -James 2:17

Just as batteries are required in order for some products to function, **WORK** is required in order for the fullness of God's will to be performed in our lives.

## WORSHIP

Because God has spoken truth and revelation into our lives ALREADY, He is worthy of praise, glory and honor due His name.

## **LEARN**

Look back over the teachings you have received this year and ask the Holy Spirit to remind you of what you have been taught. Where is HIS FOCUS?

## **SERVE**

Get involved in 60 Days of Community and discuss with other believers what you are being reminded of and how to apply it in your life.
