Read: Mark 1:2-4 (NIV)

[2] as it is written in Isaiah the prophet: "I will send my messenger ahead of you, who will prepare your way" - [3] "a voice of one calling in the wilderness, 'Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him.'" [4] And so John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness, preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.

Statement: The Holy Spirit equips us for the task that we are to accomplish.

Question: What are some gifts that God has given to you?

Read: Mark 1:5-6 (NIV)

[5] The whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem went out to him. Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River. [6] John wore clothing made of camel's hair, with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey.

Statement: The Holy Spirit ensures that the Kingdom work continues.

Question: How can you use the gifts that God has given you to contribute to the Kingdom of God?

Read: Mark 1:7-8 (NIV)

[7] And this was his message: "After me comes the one more powerful than I, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie. [8] I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."

Statement: Each generation is to take the work further and higher for the greater.

Question: How are you helping to prepare the next generation to continue to take the church further and higher?

FACTORPOINTS
