Key Scripture: Ephesian 3:17-21 (ESV)

⁷“Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. ⁸For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened. ⁹Or which one of you, if his son asks him for bread, will give him a stone? ¹⁰Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a serpent? ¹¹If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask him!

What does this passage teach you about prayer?

- How is God inviting you to approach Him?

Which word stands out to you most—Ask, Seek, or Knock? Why?

- What does that word say about your current relationship with God?

Have you ever prayed for something and saw God answer?

- What did that moment teach you about His character?

How does viewing God as a *Father* shift the way you pray?

- Does it help you pray with more confidence? Why or why not?

What are some “good gifts” God has given you—even ones you didn’t ask for?

- How can gratitude shape your future prayers?
