Real Prayer Requires the Real You - Matthew 6:9-13 (AMP)

- 1. The Real "I"
 - Are you presenting your true self to God?
 - God, this is who I really am—broken, distracted, and in need of You.
- 2. The Real "Thou"
 - Are you praying to the true God or a version you've created?

Challenge: Trust God as a loving Father who welcomes you (Hebrews 4:16).

Honesty Breaks the Masks - 2 Corinthians 3:16-18 (AMP) Common Masks We Wear:

- 1. Perfection: Pretending to have it all together.
- 2. Busyness: Using activity to hide brokenness.
- 3. Politeness: Filtering prayers to sound "right."

Key Point: God isn't fragile—He can handle your truth!

Real Prayer Brings Real Transformation - Hebrews 4:16 (NKJV)

- 1. **Freedom** comes with confession (2 Corinthians 3:17).
- 2. **God's Presence** deepens when we're authentic.
- 3. **Transformation** happens when we allow God into our hidden places (2 Corinthians 3:18).

Practical Application

- 1. Reflect on your view of God and validate it with New Testament Scripture.
- 2. Drop the masks.
- 3. Be honest with God.
- 4. Pray boldly and authentically.

Encouragement: James 1:22 – "Be doers of the Word, not hearers only."
