ROMANS 10:9 NASB

LORD: Lord in Greek is Kurios - He to whom a person or thing belongs, which he has power of deciding; master, lord. The owner; one who has control of the person.

IS YOUR SAVIOR YOUR LORD?

*That if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.
Romans 10:9 (NASB)*

In an attempt to make the gospel more attractive, we sometimes introduce Jesus to people as their Savior and leave out the part of His name that sets them free. He is Lord. We do not **make** Jesus Lord – He **is, always has been and always will be Lord!** Is it possible that the reason why some Christians do not live victorious lives is that they are living their lives without **recognizing** Jesus as their Lord?

WHO IS JESUS' COMPETITION FOR YOUR HEART?

*“Why do you call Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ and do not do what I say?”
Luke 6:46 (NASB)*

Jesus asked that question to people who understood that a slave has no right to say no to his master. On the **throne** of our lives, Jesus should have no rivals.

HOW DO WE MAKE JESUS LORD OF OUR LIVES?

The not so easy answer is, **ask** the Holy Spirit to **help** you submit your life to Christ. Many of us do not understand the **rewards** of allowing Jesus to rule our lives because we have a worldly definition of the word **submission**.

Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men. Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Philippians 2:5-11 (NASB)

FACTORPOINTS

HE'S HERE - WORSHIP

Worship Jesus as your Lord. The Lord of All! His name is exalted in Heaven. His name is exalted in your life, and one day, every tribe and tongue will also exalt His name.

HE KNOWS - LEARN

Study the benefits described in the Bible for a good and faithful servant (a life submitted to Christ).

HE'S ABLE - SERVE

Ask your Lord how you can glorify His name by serving others.
