**Text**: Genesis 4:26b – "At that time people began to call upon the name of the Lord."

## **Study the Scripture**

- 1. **Read Genesis 4:26b**: Discuss what it means for people to "call upon the name of the Lord" for the first time. Why is this significant in the biblical narrative?
- 2. **Context**: Humanity had begun to experience separation from God after the fall. How does this verse mark a shift in their relationship with Him?

#### **Main Points**

## 1. Place – We Are Separated from the Place of God

- **Key Insight**: Humanity was removed from Eden, the place where they walked with God.
  - o How does sin create separation between us and God?
  - Why do we need prayer to align ourselves with God's plans in a fallen world?

# 2. Presence – We Are Separated from the Presence of God

- **Key Insight**: Sin distanced humanity from the intimate presence of God.
  - What does it mean to experience the presence of God in prayer?
  - o How can we make prayer more about fellowship with God and less about asking for things?

# 3. Peace – We Are Separated from the Peace of God

- **Key Insight**: Prayer restores peace in a chaotic world.
  - o How has prayer helped you find peace during challenging times?
