Opening Discussion

- 1. Share a time when you or someone you know experienced something you would consider a miracle.
- 2. How do you typically define a miracle?

Key Points

1. What is a Miracle?

- **Definition:** A miracle is when God's power interrupts the natural to reveal His supernatural purpose.
 - Example: When the impossible becomes possible, like healings, provision, or transformation.
- **Revelation:** Miracles aren't just about what God does but about what He reveals—His love, power, and purpose.
- Discussion Question: How have you seen God's purpose revealed through a miraculous event?

2. Who Are Miracle Workers?

Believers Empowered by the Holy Spirit:

- Paul reminds us in 1 Corinthians 12:7 that spiritual gifts, including the ability to perform miracles, are given to all believers for the benefit of others.
- Miracle workers are image bearers of Jesus who release God's power with purpose.



- **Faith in Action:** Miracle workers don't just recognize the power God has placed in them; they release it through obedience and faith.
- Discussion Question: What does it mean to you to be a vessel for God's power? How might you reflect His love and purpose through miracles?

3. How Do Miracles Happen?

- Faith Initiates Miracles (Galatians 3:5):
 - o It's not about works but about believing God can and will intervene.
- Obedience Activates Miracles:
 - o Miracles often happen when we respond to God's prompting (e.g., praying for someone, speaking a word of encouragement).
- Humility Sustains Miracles:
 - o Recognizing that the power comes from God keeps us grounded.
- Discussion Question: What steps of faith and obedience could you take this week to allow God to work through you?
