SCRIPTURE: Psalm 138:1-8 (AMP)



¹I will give You thanks with all my heart; I sing praises to You before the [pagan] gods. ²I will bow down [in worship] toward Your holy temple And give thanks to Your name for Your lovingkindness and Your truth; For You have magnified Your word together with Your name. ³On the day I called, You answered me; And You made me bold *and* confident with [renewed] strength in my life. ⁴All the kings of the land will give thanks *and* praise You, O Lord, When they have heard of the promises of Your mouth [which were fulfilled]. ⁵Yes, they will sing of the ways of the Lord [joyfully celebrating His wonderful acts], For great is the glory *and* majesty of the Lord. ⁶ Though the Lord is exalted, He regards the lowly [and invites them into His fellowship]; But the proud *and* haughty He knows from a distance. ⁷ Though I walk in the midst of trouble, You will revive me; You will stretch out Your hand against the wrath of my enemies, And Your right hand will save me ⁸ The Lord will accomplish that which concerns me; Your [unwavering] lovingkindness, O Lord, endures forever— Do not abandon the works of Your own hands.
