SCRIPTURE: Mark 5:21-43 NASB Pastor Jeffrey Johnson, II

INTRODUCTION

Author Germany Kent penned a quote "Let your life reflect the faith you have in God. Fear nothing and pray about everything. Be strong, trust God's word and trust the process." In these few words a <u>challenge</u> is issued to the believer. In other words, the way we live, walk, talk and act should reflect the faith we profess in God. The question for us is, "What do our actions say about our faith?"

I HEAR THEREFORE I BELIEVE

When Jesus begins His journey to Jairus' house, He is interrupted by a woman with her own *issue*. This woman had been living with this ailment for 12 years. Instead of *succumbing* to the notion that she would never be healed, when she heard Jesus was passing by her belief made her act upon it.

A SETUP FOR A GREATER MIRACLE

During the conversation with the woman, Jesus over hears the news that Jairus' daughter has died. His reply is <u>epic</u>, He says "Do not be afraid, just believe." When the status of the situation changes, Jesus' <u>power</u> remains the same... both then and now.

WHO HAS ACCESS TO YOUR ROOM?

Jesus and Jairus enter the room where his daughter is presumed dead to find the people mourning her death. When He <u>attempts</u> to encourage them, they mock Him by laughing. Jesus kicks everyone out but her mother and father. Jesus wasn't doing this out of disrespect. In this moment He needed the people near Him who believed the <u>impossible</u> could be <u>possible</u>. When everything is on the line, we must ask ourselves who we can trust to have that same kind of faith, the faith that God can and will do over and above what we see.

HE'S HERE - WORSHIP

Worship God who has met and is meeting and is exceeding your expectations.

HE KNOWS - LEARN

Read and meditate on Mark 5:21-43. Ask yourself what would you have done if you were in Jairus' shoes?

HE'S ABLE - SERVE

Serve others by sharing what God has done for you and encourage them to remember what He said in His word.
