Review

Ephesians 5:22-24

²² <u>WIVES</u>, submit to your husbands <u>as</u> to the Lord,

²³ because the husband is the <u>head</u> of the wife <u>as</u> Christ is the head of the Church. He is the Savior of the body.

²⁴ Now <u>as</u> the Church submits to Christ, so also wives are to submit to their husbands in everything.

²⁵ <u>HUSBANDS,</u> love your wives, <u>just as</u> Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her...

²⁸ In the same way, husbands are to love their wives <u>as</u> their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself.
